

2020 Worthington Wood Bat Tournament Covid-19 Guidelines



- Please be respectful to all school district and facility policies. Many have specific rules that pertain to their facilities. Remember they can shut us down at any time if rules are not followed.
- We ask that teams take the temperature of your players and coaches the morning of competition. Any player that has over 100-degree temperature is asked to stay home or at the hotel.
- Recommended that players ride to and from games only with family members or legal guardians.
- Individuals 65 and over or those known with preexisting medical conditions should remain cautious about attending the games.
- Face coverings may be required for spectators depending on location or facility policies.
- Spectators should space out as much as possible while viewing the games.
- No team water coolers.
- Please refrain from high fives, handshake lines and other physical contact with teammates, opposing players, coaches, umpires and fans
- Teams are responsible for supplying baseballs. We ask that each use their own baseballs while on defense.
- Coaches are responsible for maintaining social distancing between players.
- Infielders should refrain from coming to the pitcher's mound during coaching visits unless absolutely necessary.
- Many facilities will not have concession stands and/or restroom facilities open, please plan accordingly.
- Please clean all trash out of the dugout after your game.
- If batting cages are available at the field, please keep spacing while waiting or entering the cage.
- Players can not share equipment.
- No spitting of seeds, gums or other similar products.
- Individuals should not congregate in the common areas or parking lot before/after games.
